The news of the Chaplain Tower collapse in Surfside, Florida, is tragic and shocking. Our residents have been asking about our building structural safety. We want you to know we track all structural maintenance repairs. Diligent visual inspections are required every nine years. Which we do more often than that. Recently, we focused on our building's foundation. We repaired spalling damages in garages, ramps and roads which is all part of our structural maintenance. In response to the incident in Florida our board is reviewing all of our maintenance procedures and inspection policies. We want to make sure we are complying with the safety guidelines required by state laws and ensure we are doing everything to keep this building structurally sound.

Phase one of our building renovation project completion is slightly behind schedule. We apologize for the inconveniences as we try to wrap up phase one. While we have just a few items to finish in the main lobby including installation of the wood panels and the onyx, we will be able to continue to work with minimal, to no noise with both the entryway and lobby open to residents and guests. The fountains and planters will also need to be completed. Thank you for your patience during the lobby and entryway work. Phase two will begin in the fall.
